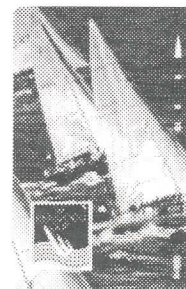

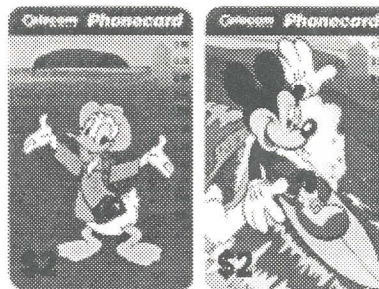

Historic Post Offices of Australia

The first in what is anticipated to be a series of collector phonecards entitled Historic Post Offices of Australia, is being issued by the Post Office Agents Association Limited (POAAL), in October. It will be launched at the Association's National Conference to be held at the Surfers Paradise Travelodge on 15-16 October, 1994.

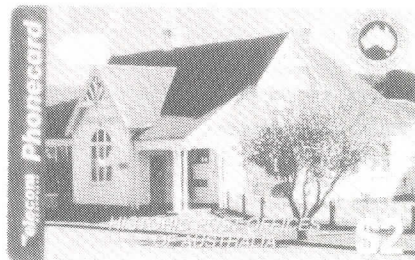
The POAAL is the official representative organisation of all Licensed Post Offices and Agencies. POAAL was formed over 60 years ago, it has six State Branches and a National Office, and represents its members in all states of Australia.

Post Offices in Australia fall into two categories: Licensed and Corporate. Licensed Post Offices comprise over 70% of the Post Office network and are privately owned and operated. Some are stand alone Post Offices, some operate in conjunction with another business such as a newsagency and/or general store. There are Licensed Post Office buildings in all States which are suitable subjects for the Heritage Post Offices of Australia series.

The Fingal, Tasmanian Post Office is the first featured in the series.

On 1 June, 1832, Lt. Governor Arthur proclaimed the establishment of a government department to run postal services in Van Diemens Land. Twenty offices were established initially and of these, fifteen still exist.

Fingal was one of those twenty offices. No precise records have been found stating exactly when the present building was built, but the "Weekly Courier" of 13 July, 1907, has a photo of the present building. At one point it was an "official" Post Office but was converted to Non-Official in April, 1929. The present owner and operator of the Fingal Post Office is Mr Les Rubenach.



The Telecom Phonecard is being packaged by Sprintpak. The pack is attractively priced at under \$10.00 (RRP \$8.90) and will be available from many Licensed Post Offices, or direct by mail from the Post Office Agents Association.

Future issues will feature other heritage/historic Licensed Post Offices in other States.

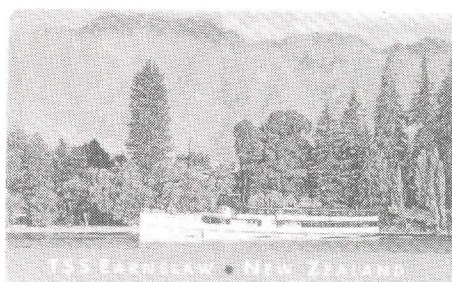
SYDNEY STAMP CENTRE

"STAMP CLASSICS" PHONECARD SERIES

The Telecom Australia "**Inverted Swan**" Phonecard (pictured on pages 12 & 15), is the first to be issued anywhere in the Pacific region depicting a postage stamp and is expected to prove very popular with stamp collectors as well as phonecard collectors. This card boasts another "first", being the first Custom card issued by Telecom with the new style denomination grid along the top, the word "USED" appears where previously was shown "0.00".

It is anticipated that issue of the second "Stamp Classic Series" will be in early 1995. It is envisaged that featured on issue 2. will be the colourfull New South Wales 1897, 2/6d Charity issue.

"Stamp Classics" Card 1. showing the Western Australia "Inverted Swan" was issued via Phonecard Advertising & Collector Services (PACS) in October, in a total print run of 10,000 x \$5 cards. Distribution was 3,000 loose cards sent to overseas agents and 4,000 cards will be sold through PACS Australian agents. The remaining 3,000 cards (bearing serial numbers 0002-3001) were purchased by the NSW Chapter of the Australasian Stamp Dealers Assoc. (ASDA). These 3,000 cards are in facially different packaging, bearing a metallic silver ASDA logo and the words "Stamp Classic Series". Of these, approx half will be sold as single cards and the other half in a Limited Edition pack. This is a tiny number, even for a Custom card.

The ASDA Chapter retained a very substantial sum from the sale of these "Silver Logo" phonecards to its members. These monies will be utilised to directly support and promote the growth of stamp and phonecard collecting.

The Western Australia 1854 "Inverted Swan" Error ("Stamp Classic Series" Card No. 1)

The Australasian Stamp Dealers' Association (NSW and ACT Chapter) has just released the first ever Phonecard in the Australasian region to depict a postage stamp. This \$5 Telecom Australia Phonecard was commissioned via Phonecard Advertising & Collector Services.

The card illustrated above is available in **very limited numbers**. The ASDA contracted to buy only 3000 of these \$5 cards in total, and only about half of these were issued in a Limited Edition collector pack. Both are distinguished by packaging bearing the hot foil Silver "Stamp Classics Series" wording, along with the ASDA logo. (As shown above.) **PLEASE NOTE:** These are custom cards, and are **NOT** available to collectors or dealers via Telecom Phonecard Collector Service.

The example of the "Inverted Swan" featured on the card is courtesy of Macray Watson, who auctioned the stamp in 1993. The "Inverted Swan" is the most valuable single stamp ever to have been issued by Australia or the Australian Colonies. Only seven copies exist in private hands worldwide, and most of these are damaged or defective.

This issue is expected to prove very popular - many stamp collectors who have hitherto not purchased phonecards may decide to buy this issue, because of its philatelic theme and the tiny issue number. Early ordering is advised.

The ASDA Chapter plans to issue "Stamp Classic Series" Card No. 2 in early 1995. This card will feature the very pretty NSW 1897 2/6d Charity issue - the world's first multicoloured stamp issue. Similar numbers of this issue will be released. You may pre-order the second issue from the ASDA Chapter members.

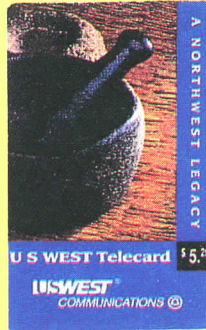

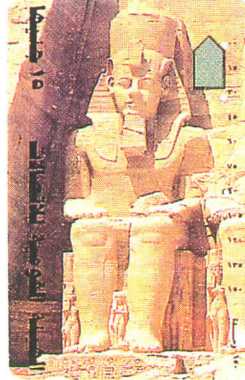

FOCUS ON FARAWAY PLACES

This Month: EGYPT

by Cyril Fox

Phonecards were first introduced in the ancient nation of Egypt in 1985. Three different trial cards (500 of each) were supplied in this year by Mantegazza of Milan for use in Urmet payphones (*see opposite page*).

The first issue of public cards was in 1986; these cards were concurrently in use with a further batch of trial cards. Further regular issues of similar design followed in 1987 and 1988.

Whilst the initial Mantegazza cards were made of laminated cardboard, 1989 saw the introduction of PVC cards which were manufactured by Technicard Polaroid. These cards however, still adhered to the old Mantegazza design.

In 1990/91 Egypt switched to Japanese style Anritsu cards picturing ancient landmarks of the country, such as the Sphinx and Ramses at Luxor (*see opposite again*).

The first commemorative phonecards were issued for the occasion of the Telecom '94 Conference in the capital, Cairo (*see fourth card opposite page*).

SOUTH AFRICAN SCENE

TELKOM

Following the very attractive issue of animal phonecards (which is now almost sold out), Telkom brought out its second and rather drab issue featuring child art. Recently released in South Africa is the R10 "generic" card pictured below:



The next new issue of six cards will feature the Eagles of Southern Africa (*see opposite & above*). Telkom also had a special "election" issue featuring two high value cards of R100 and R200. These cards picture Table Mountain at dusk.

TRANSTEL

Transtel, the other telephone company in South Africa, has now re-issued the gold coin phonecards,

this time showing the correct telephone number. The first issue was misprinted and all but 50 sets of the cards were de-activated and "dumped". The de-activated cards are available for fraction of their original face value.

THE GRAPEVINE

by Insider

This month should prove to be very interesting with many bargains for the astute collector. A situation has developed which will possibly never occur again within Australian Phonocard collecting. This has been brought about by a combination of unrelated circumstances, each happening at just the same time.

Basically, this is what has happened. New Zealand collectors/investors and dealers started buying up Australian packs in quantities. This resulted in rapid price rises as demand exceeded supply in the short term. The price fall in the New Zealand market stopped many from New Zealand buying anything and dealers in Australia who had previously been advertising to buy packs at very high prices, now no longer needed buy the same quantity as just a few weeks ago. Dealers normally pay around 60% of advertised price but I was able to get up to 85% of list price from some dealers over the last two months. In effect, dealers were taking smaller margins because the stock was selling immediately and did not need to be held in the shop until a customer came in to buy the item.

So why is this developing into a good time to find bargains? Read on!

Coinciding with these events, a rumour started to circulate that Telecom was going to release the information about the number of packs destroyed. Dealers/investors and collectors started to speculate on which were the really hard packs to obtain and tried to anticipate the resulting price rise for the packs that turned out to be scarcer than expected. Much confusion occurred in the market prices and all involved, started to lose track of what an item was really worth. Dealer price lists and advertised prices over this period started to show diverging figures with quite large differences on many items. Last month, I mentioned the Red Cross pack which was being offered from \$220 to \$500 by different dealers. In effect, some packs etc., may have gone up too much in price whilst others may not have gone up enough!

So why is this developing into a good time to find bargains? Read on!

Dealers were getting fed up with changing prices every second day and at the end of August, started to produce price lists that anticipated price rises for the next 2-4 weeks. This was to avoid the 'hassle' of finding their advertisements in the magazines appear with selling prices lower than their buying prices, due to the speed at which prices were rising. Some investors/dealers also thought that the price fall in New Zealand packs would be followed by a corresponding price fall for Australian packs.

So why is this developing into a good time to find bargains? Read on!

- (1) Telecom Australia have decided (on November 1) to release the figures on quantities of packs destroyed!
- (2) Some dealers may have bought in some stock that they did not on-sell immediately!
- (3) No one knows which packs are the ones that are overpriced or underpriced!
- (4) Prices in New Zealand went "crazy", whereas in Australia they have only moved up steadily after a relatively long period of stability. They were in effect due for a "catch up" in prices.

The result of all this confusion?

Bargains will be likely in the short term (possibly only October), as once Telecom release the figures for packs destroyed, a quick revision of prices will occur. If you wait to find out that pack 'X' had only 2,000 released and then expect to buy it at the "cheap price", you will find that it is no longer at that "cheap price". I expect a revision of most dealer's prices in early November as the 'dust settles' and all involved realise what the current price levels should be!

How do you recognise the bargains?

Look for the quoted price range for a particular pack and then decide whether the "low" price seems value for money after taking account of your decision as to which packs are really the scarce ones. Be aware however that a small dealer/collector advertiser may not have many of a particular pack and so their selling price may not be representative of all this type of pack.

Assume that the Geelong pack is not as scarce (relatively to other packs) and that its present price is too high. Current quoted prices for Geelong are between \$320 and \$495 and so a price may be closer to \$350 after Telecom release their information. If on the other hand it turns out to be more scarce than anticipated, it could end up at the \$475 level!

The action?

To a certain extent, it is a bit of good luck if you buy a "value" pack this month as you could find the "revalued" price goes up or down as the information is released. Make your own decision with this information in mind.

To make it interesting, the Editor has agreed to donate some prizes for a competition which will be run along the following lines:-

Readers are asked to send in their own estimates for the number of packs released into circulation (to arrive before October 28th). Scores will be added up to arrive at a total error - this could be the one time Telecom are completely correct and all us collectors are absolutely wrong!.

CARDEX '94 REPORT

WORLD CONFERENCE & FAIR A HUGE SUCCESS - AND FOR AUSTRALIA!!

The Cardex '94 Conference & Exhibition has been held in Amsterdam, between September 8th and the 11th. Telecom Australia was represented in more ways than one!! At a special Gala Awards Dinner on the Friday evening (September the 9th), Telecom Australia almost "scooped the pool" with their entries in the Cardex annual awards.

The Environmental Series designed by Simone Tetof of Melbourne won two awards - outright winner of the Environment Award and a Certificate of Excellence for the Innovative Card Design Award (this was won by PTT Netherlands for their Satellite Dish card of May 1994), representing both German and Dutch combined technologies). The other award to Telecom Australia was a Certificate of Merit in the Best Card Series section - this time for the Australian Landscape set of 1994.

Telecom Australia Well Represented

The team from Telecom Australia was capably headed by Nelda Slezak of the Parramatta office, with support from Arthur Bushell and Harry Grieve. All were able to attend the conference sessions on the first one and a half days, which gave the latest technical and design information in worldwide phonecards, and the opportunity to personally meet some of the key figures in the industry.

Dr. Steve Hiscocks and his wife, Veronica, represented the International Telephone Cards magazine, but in fact were the driving force behind Cardex 94. Steve Hiscocks, a tall and charismatic man, is a scientist by profession, (majored in Geology) and until 1991, worked for the Civil Service in the United Kingdom in the area of Materials Science & Energy.

Not knowing the potential of Telephone Card Collecting as a hobby, he had unknowingly written a Catalogue of Telegraph and Telephone Stamps in 1982, which gives a complete account of these 'stamps' issued around a century ago. (This Catalogue is still available from Dr. Steve Hiscocks).

In 1985, he realised the collectability of Phonecards, and has since written several well-known Catalogues on the subject. However, it is not

generally appreciated that his first world Catalogue on Phonecards was issued in 1988, called "The Collector's Book of Telephone Cards 1988-1989", to be followed in 1990 by the better known, "The Stanley Gibbons Catalogue of Telephone Cards". Both these publications have become collectors items in their own right.

Another key person from the organisation of Cardex was Sue Dickison from the head office in Colchester, UK., who kept both the Conference and Exhibition flowing throughout.

Key Speakers at the Conference

The Conference itself was opened by Mr. W. Dik, the Chairman of PTT Telecom Netherlands. His initial comments about one major difference between stamps and telephone cards were significant; phonecards permit **ADVERTISING**, whereas stamps in general do not (some early New Zealand stamps had advertisements on the reverse).

The progress in phonecards is towards **CHIP** technology, and perhaps in the future there may be **ONE** card for all purposes (retailing, communications, transport, etc.) which would be **RECHARGEABLE** and used in **ALL COUNTRIES**.

The possibility of one European phonecard is almost a reality, as already Germany and The Netherlands phonecards are interchangeable. Other countries investigating this concept are Switzerland, France and Spain.

Probably the most important speech was from Barclay Fitzpatrick, who is trying to develop a global "RESPONSIBLE ISSUING POLICY" (perhaps generated from many suspect issuers in the USA, who issue purely for the collector market).

In essence, a responsible issuer has the primary purpose of production and distribution of cards to CONSUMERS of telephone services - the COLLECTABLE telephone cards should be secondary to this principal. There should be a commitment to avoiding intentional or unintentional EXPLOITATION of the market for collectable telephone cards.

The process would be to form a worldwide Policy Review Board, where issuers can be assessed, registered and periodically re-evaluated. Support would also be essential from the Journals, Catalogues, and collector-specialists and experts (it is of interest that the official issues and general policy of Telecom Australia would easily qualify them to be a 'Responsible Issuing Authority').

As another speaker said (Frank Magliato of the Windsor Group, USA), "the United States is the 'Sleeping Giant' in the prepaid telephone card market". With the real possibility of many issuers in the USA trying to "cash-in" with the collector market, it is essential to insure the long-term viability of this market.

The Fair & Exhibition

This was held at the huge exhibition complex in suburban Amsterdam - The RAI. The Fair was held in the combined Oosthall and Nordhall, comprising some 5,000 to 6,000 square metres of lettable area. Some 72 exhibitors took part, varying from official Telcos, Collector Clubs, private Telephone Companies, and a range of Phonecard dealers.

A popular innovation was the Swap Area, where individual collectors could swap and barter with others, using English (and sometimes French) as a common language. It may be a good idea for Fairs in Australia to introduce a Swap Area, as collectors sit down on chairs or the floor and at least the Swap Area keeps them together and reasonably organised. The stand of Telecom Australia was very popular, with a special phonecard/folder just for Cardex 94. A total of 10,000 were 'shipped' to Amsterdam, of which roughly half were sold. The balance of the folders were destroyed by Telecom staff on the Sunday evening. The Phonecards all had a low serial number - 5,900.... onwards - and featured an attractive Australian Wildflower design (wattles, banksia, etc.). The folder itself - somewhat similar to the card for the 1992 Christmas 'Choir of Native Birds' - will become a scarce collectors item, in Australia. Most in fact were sold to individual UK and European collectors, and with an initial limit of 100 only. By the Sunday afternoon, the limit was extended to a further 100 card/folders, so that no dealer was able to get a monopoly on the issue.

The overall disappointment was that only approx. 3,500 collectors attended the 2 1/2-day Fair.

Proportionally, we would get far more collectors to a Fair in Australia, as Amsterdam has the potential to draw on a population of over 200 million in Europe and the UK. A limiting factor is that there is a reluctance to travel long distances.

The bulk of collectors seemed to be adult males.

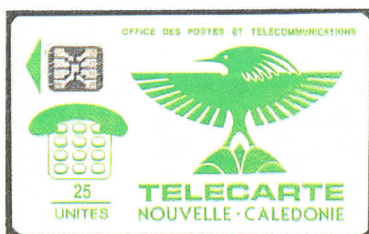
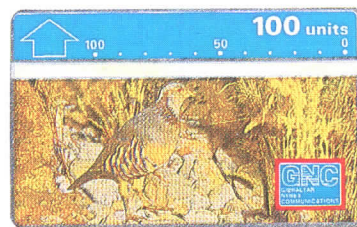
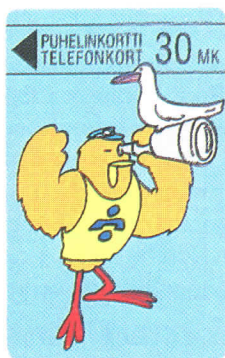

THEMATIC - Birds

From Intercards

by Peter Granfield

A large percentage of phonecard collectors, having found all the easy Australian cards and perhaps not currently being able to afford the expensive cards that they are missing, have turned their attention to other areas of phonecard collecting. Typical examples have been, one card from each issuing country, one from each type of system, test or trial cards or as in very many cases, a thematic collection. This has been a natural progression, supported by individual natural interests and the in-built trend established over many years amongst the many people who are also philatelists. This month we will look at some of the interesting cards issued that feature birds. (See opposite page.)

Ascension Islands - A set was issued in 1990, comprising four cards. One however was a complimentary issue with only 100 issued and had the same picture as the GBP15 card. A later 1992 issue, added a GBP25 card to the set and this high value card with only 5000 issued is rather elusive and expensive.

Benin - This card and its matching 50 unit in different colours, is an interesting stylised bird and comes well within the parameter of bird collecting. Cards of Benin have always been difficult to find.

Brazil - This very bright card has been issued by one of the many districts in Brazil. There have been a few other less stunning bird issues from Brazil, but information on issues and companies in Brazil is still very vague.

Falkland Islands - Their third issue of three penguins included this beautiful card. Each value had an issue quantity of 45,000. St. Helena, the other British Atlantic Island has also issued two cards with birds on them.

Finland - This cartoon character called "Tomtit" has been used on at least 20 issues from the TTL company. The cards vary in colour and in each case, Tomtit is illustrated in a different costume, varying from sports to music and Christmas. Card values range from 5Mk to 100Mk and come in issue quantities of 3,000 to 60,000. Finding a full set may take some searching.

Great Britain - Another nice digression, a company with a bird name - "Kite Communications". Formerly International Payphones Ltd., Kite supply payphones to private locations. Their first issue of four cards under the 'Kite' label, depict different

line drawings of Kites. They also have an Engineers Test card which has a Kite logo on it. Mercury, recently issued a very colourful card with a Kingfisher on it.

Gibraltar - Gibraltar Nynex issued this card featuring the Barbary Partridge as part of a set of five cards in 1992. It was the only bird in the set.

Japan - No thematic collection would be complete without some Japanese cards. From the forty different we have in stock we selected this beautiful card for this article.

Seychelles - Another island nation that is producing very beautiful cards. This one features the Comoro Blue Pigeon which is only found on the Aldabra Atoll.

Some other countries that collectors can look at for 'Bird' cards include:- Australia, Belgium, Canada, China, Denmark, France, Indonesia, Ireland, Jamaica, Jersey, Korea, Macau, Malaysia, Montserrat, New Zealand, Oman, St. Helena, St. Lucia, Singapore, South Africa, Sweden, UAE, USA, Uganda and Uruguay.

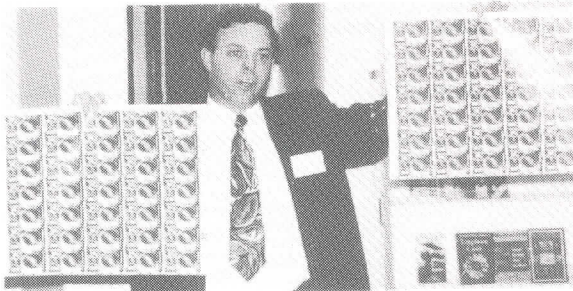

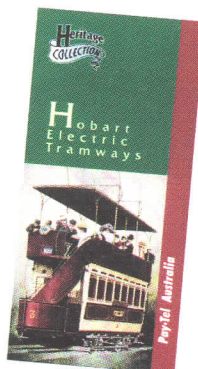

Telstra's Vietnam Phonocard

Following some research, I have obtained some interesting information in relation to the Telstra OTC US\$50 Phonocard which was produced for the two week, China Beach Surf Carnival held in Vietnam in late 1993. (Card features on page 12 of the magazine and page 40 - Classifieds).

Telecom sent three only, payphones over to Vietnam for the Surf Carnival. The payphones were set up for the Danang Post & Telecom who were responsible for the sale of the Phonocards. Telstra staff from Australia set up the payphones on the beachfront and were responsible for their ongoing maintenance. The payphones were set up for International calling and were connected remotely to the Telstra satellite base station in Vietnam. There was only one type of Phonocard available for sale at the Carnival. It had a price of US\$50. It could only be used in the specially installed payphones. The cards were of the Generic International series "Earth Map". The code on the reverse side of the card is I930519. The serial number prefix of the card featured is 0028912127 indicating that it is following the Australian numbering system. Most of the markings on the card are preprinted, however the country of use, unit price, bar code and the serial number have been printed after the card was initially produced. (It looks as if it was done with ink jet printing). It is believed that less than 150 Vietnam cards were used at the Carnival. It is also believed that the balance were returned to Telstra.

New technology in photochromic dye screen printing has been developed in Japan by Senka, and Sarria Pty Ltd has been licensed to promote the photochromic dye via phonecard advertising in Australia.

The water based print is reactive to ultra violet rays. When exposed to UV rays the print appears in red, blue or yellow colours. These colours intensify depending upon the level of intensity of ultra violet at the time of exposure. When removed from direct exposure the colour print disappears.

The new technology provides for very rapid response times into and out of colour. These photochromic dyes can be printed on to normal print substrates such as paper, plastic and textiles, with no change to the texture of the substrate.

With increasing public interest and awareness of the harmful effects of ultra violet radiation to human skin and interior furnishings and fabrics, photochromic prints can readily identify the presence of solar ultra violet rays.
