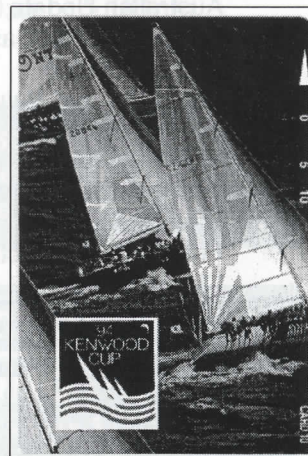

EDITORIAL

Something different this month. The editorial is drawn from a letter received from **Bruce Reineker** from **Kyogle, NSW**, containing his impressions of the current state of the phonocard collecting hobby.

"As this small-time collector sees it the phonocard hobby is poised at an interesting stage. The hobby now seems to be endeavouring to make up its mind about future directions. Will it gather itself for the price adjustments and maturity of temporarily reduced and then steadily growing demand and prices, in an orderly resurgence, or will it quietly fade away to be nought but a forgotten temporary enthusiasm?

In an effort to fill some gaps in my collection, I recently wandered from dealer to dealer through Sydney's CBD as I have done over the past several years. In doing so, I gathered a variety of impressions which only served to bolster that feeling of a hobby betwixt and between.

One dealer had fewer than a hundred cards for me to sift through and gave me the distinct impression that I was nothing short of daft if I put out good money should I find any cards that I needed.

Another dealer said "We're trying to get out of them. There's no demand. We don't buy any now." Like that first dealer, he had nothing in the way of the latest issues.

I wonder whether the attitudes expressed by each of these dealers explain why they have little demand or reflect present and continuing realities.

Of course, my contacts with all shopfront dealers were by no means negative for as I plunk away at the keyboard I can think of at least three others whom I visited and found to be well stocked, enthusiastic and able to fill some gaps for me.

I visited two fairs that weekend and the contrast between them was major. On the Saturday, I found only one book of phonocards to peruse in the whole place. That dealer said, "There's no call for them so I don't bring them. When space is at a premium something has to be left out". Again, I wonder whether that attitude explains why he has little phonocard demand or in fact reflects reality.

My visit the next day to the Bankstown Stamp & Coin Fair was a major contrast for here I found a lively phonocard scene with four dealers with wide ranges of phonocards at buyable prices.

Having noted that the phonocard scene is rather quiet I pondered possible reasons and came up with these:

. The passing of an initial burst of enthusiasm for a new collecting area;

. The realisation that, as with all collecting areas, prices do not continue on an ever-upward spiral;

. The absence of a really up-to-date phonocard catalogue, regularly revised to indicate collection completeness. This expensive exercise may eventuate with maturity of the hobby and Telstra eliminating publication difficulties;

. Telstra's gimmicky issuing policies which limit availability, eg. the \$2 fish promotional card being available only in a pack. Not satisfactory for used card collectors;

. The poor advance warning of coming issues via "Australian Phonocard Bulletin". This could be rectified if the "Australian Stamp Bulletin" example were followed so collectors know early what to look for, when, and withdrawal dates. The Standing Orders system is of no value to the impoverished collector of used cards;

. The get-rich-quick mentality of some entrepreneurs who seek to milk the gullible with sure-fire "Investment Opportunities".

Lest I leave you with a feeling that all is lost on the phonocard collecting scene let me balance that with some positives and reasons for hope:

. The strength and optimism of the dealer base which advertises in the APM;

. The courtesy, positive attitudes and efficiency of most dealers in general;

. The attractive designs of most Telstra issues;

. The creative ideas of people like Leora Doctors (APM April '96) who suggested that Telstra advertise our hobby in phone booths;

. The rapid spread to world-wide phonocard use, which has led to collecting beyond merely one country;

. The great range of designs which support and encourage thematic collecting.

In conclusion, I enjoy phonocard collecting; I believe that it has a future and I would never seek to put it down. I simply feel that our hobby is in a parlous state at the moment and needs some deep thought, concerted long term effort and changes in attitudes and actions in order to maintain current adherents and attract others. I live in hope that this is happening".

INTERNATIONAL EXPERIENCE

Eddie Cummings Jnr.

Recently, Eddie Cummings Snr. and son Eddie Jnr. took a long overdue business trip to the USA, Canada and Europe. The idea of the journey was to take in as many International Fairs and Exhibitions as possible in three weeks as well as meet with dealers and clients in the cities visited.

Being dealers in coins, stamps and, of course, phonecards there was a great deal to see and do and, unfortunately, very little time available.

Longbeach

The first stop on the tour was the **Longbeach Show** in Los Angeles. Longbeach has the distinction of being the biggest show in the world. Held twice each year, it attracts about 300 dealers - yes 300!! The majority of this number is made up by coin dealers, but there were about 10 dealers in attendance who were trading solely in phonecards. Many of the coin dealers were also selling phonecards in addition to their coins.

The show was held from the 29th of May the 2nd of June. With the number of dealers in attendance, five days is only just enough time to see a good percentage of them.

CAPEX

The next major show we attended was the **Capex World Stamp Expo** held in Toronto from the 7th to 9th of June. This was mainly a stamp show with about 40 to 50 dealers and about the same number of Postal Administrators in attendance.

At the Capex fair I was lucky enough to run into "Santa" - obviously on holidays from the North Pole. I met Santa (a keen and well known Coke collector) at the Bell Canada stand.



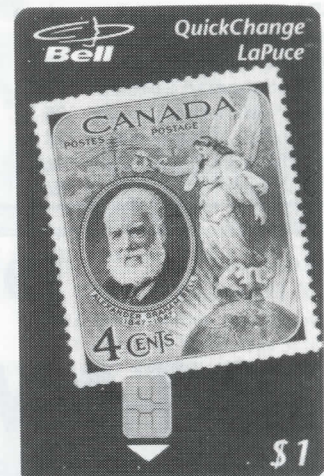

Essen

The last major show we attended was in Germany at the **Essen International Stamp and Phonecard Fair**. The fair had attracted approximately 30 to 40 stamp dealers and about 10 phonecard dealers.

The majority of stock on display was either German or Japanese thematics. The German cards are fairly expensive with a minimum price for common cards being about 2 to 3 Marks. There was very little other foreign material on offer.

Most people were chasing **Coke thematics** and I was asked more than once if I had the latest offerings from Australia, ie. Coke issue VI.

To sum up the trip, it was an experience worth having and I made some very useful contacts whilst overseas. I also brought back some quality stock which provides us with a more diverse range to offer our customers.

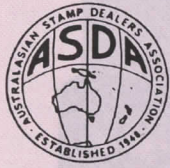

INDONESIAN UPDATE

Jusuf Kadir from Jakarta, Indonesia, reports that on the 4th of June a very important event took place, whereby Telkom Indonesia for the first time issued a "friendship" phonecard with the Slovak Republic.

The promotion was launched by the Minister of Tourism, Posts and Telecommunications, **Mr Joop Ave** and the Ambassador of the Slovak Republic, H.E. **Mr Peter Ambrovic** at the Shangri-La Hotel, in Jakarta.

The two cards issued, feature **Borobudur Temple** in Indonesia and **Spis Castle** in Slovakia. 300,000 of each card have been printed, but only 200 folders have been printed. The folder contains the two phonecards.



Jusuf reports also, that Telkom Indonesia recently issued cards which featured the **Jaguar** (400,000) and the **Kasuari** (400,000). The Kasuari, which is found only in eastern Indonesia, is a relative to the Australian Emu.



Indonesia's First Chip Phonecard

On the 7th of June, Indonesia entered a new era in telephone cards with the launch of the first Indonesian chip card.



Quantities issued and the date for proposed roll-out are unknown at this stage, but Jusuf has indicated he will advise as soon as known.

Indo-Phonecards '96

Indo-Phonecards '96 will be held from the **6th to the 8th of December** later this year, in the Plaza Senayan, the "most luxurious" shopping centre in Jakarta. **More on this later.**

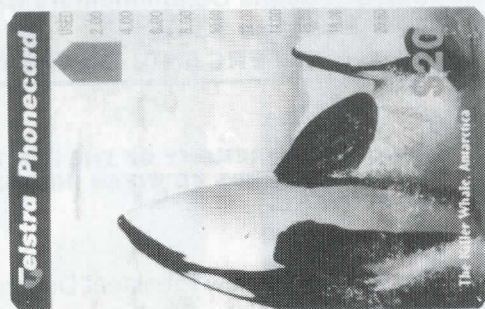
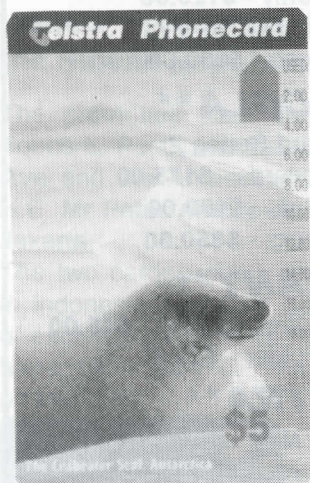

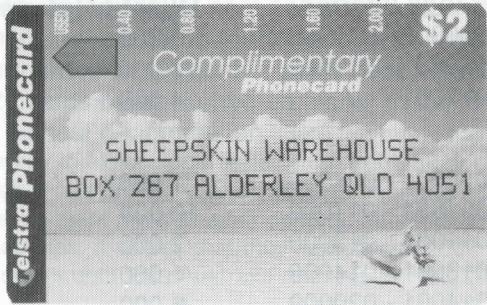

Michael Field in "The Australian" reports that the "world's last territory without phones has moved a step closer to going telephone". The remote New Zealand Territory of Tokelau has signed a contract with Telstra to build a satellite telecommunications network which will operate by the end of the year. The 200 homes on the island will each get a phone. Local calls will be free and only card phones will be able to direct-dial internationally. With such a small network of card phones, the cards themselves are likely to excite strong interest among collectors.

Sightings now confirm the existence of all denominations/print code combinations that were previously only speculation.

The table confirms that the **NAB \$5 card** is the **scarcest** "face-different" card with a quantity of only 1000, which is no surprise. While the NAB \$5 card has been snapped up whenever seen, and is now long sold out, the **NAB \$50** is still available on the Gold Coast, but this is the **second scarcest** with a quantity of only 2,000. As most of the NAB \$50 cards have been used by the public and discarded, there are conceivably many fewer than the 2000 produced still in existence, whereas most of the 1000 NAB \$5 cards are now in collections and dealer's stocks. **This may well mean that in time the \$50 card and not the \$5 card becomes the key to the NAB set.**

Among the scarce denomination/print code combinations, the \$5 Disposable cards in print codes 05022 and 05024 (ie, the codes which include the NAB and Credit Union cards) are both likely to be printed in quantities of no more than 1000 each. This is shown almost conclusively by the sighted serial numbers of the cards above and below them in the table.

This raises the **question** of just how collectable print code varieties will become. At the moment it is relatively easy to obtain a collection of all the face-different cards (in-house test cards excluded), making specialisation on such matters as print codes attractive. **After all, this is how serial number collecting with Telstra Phonecards began.**

Whereas Phonecard serial numbers continue to be a somewhat "ad hoc" system, perhaps shown up best by the "600" runs (although highly desirable, there is no evidence to suggest that these cards were printed separately from the remainder), Visa Cash print codes appear to have some constant relationship to the individual banks issuing the cards.

All the NAB Gold Coast Trial cards carry the "05022" code. In addition, the NAB Test cards carry a similar "0522" print code. This system carries over to some other Test cards with the Credit Union Test cards carrying the "0524" print code.

There remain some further **unsolved mysteries** in our table. First among these is the apparent "foul-up" of the numbering pattern in **print code 05025**, where the serials run from \$5 cards straight to \$50 cards - the \$20 cards being numbered higher in this code - whereas in all others they follow a continuation from lowest to highest denomination. Here the quantities of \$20 cards are by far the largest of any print code, and this may be the key to explaining the deviation from the normal pattern.

Also, it has proven very **difficult** to estimate the quantities of \$50 cards produced, as the general pattern of numbering means there are no higher denominations to "cap" the serial numbers seen. However, where we can estimate \$50 card quantities, it seems that they lie between 2000 and 5000. In this one area it seems that we will not get any conclusive answers until Visa Australia releases printing quantities.

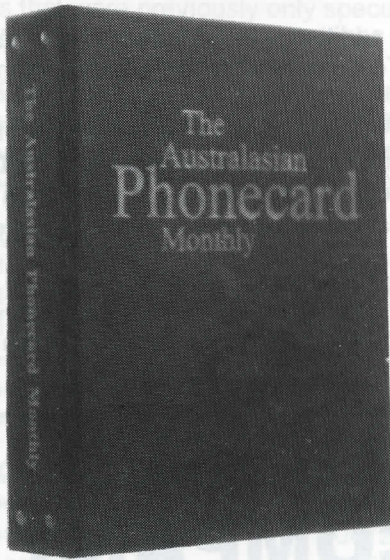

AUSTRALIAN VISA CASH TRIAL CARDS - Code & Serial Number Info.

The **prefix number** is located at the bottom left of the rear of each Visa Cash card. The **institution code** lies to the top right immediately before the card number. It is believed that each institution 'batch' of cards such as 49511, 49512 and 49513, are printed consecutively. In the case of the ANZ Disposable batches 49511 to 49513, the \$5 card was printed first. The \$20 card was then started at the next number after the \$5 card finished. Another way of saying that is to think of all the cards, \$5, \$10 and \$20, being placed in the numbering machine and starting from zero going until the cards are numbered.

Visa Cash cards can now be **tested for value** (without using a payphone or "fixed" reader) by using small Visa Cash card "Testers". These are available from the Melbourne Phonocard Centre at a cost of \$35.00.

THE GRAPEVINE

by Insider

Judging by last month's magazine many dealers have decided to advertise selling these cards now! I knew they were really interested all along! The situation is that some cards have now sold out and will turn out to be quite rare. This applies more to the Cafeteria trial cards than the Gold Coast due to the obvious number of individuals on the Gold Coast who have been gathering cards for the last seven months.

Still, all will be very sought after in a very short space of time. With all the interest shown in finding number ranges I am surprised that no-one noticed the real "prefix code" on each Visa Cash Card! Maybe those who did notice are in the race to find the last number for each batch of cards!!!

The real serial number lies in the lower left of the rear of the card. Numbers to date range from 49511 to 49531 with the theme park cards having numbers 49601 to 49605.

Each serial number is used for only one institution denomination of card. For example, 49517 is used for the Credit Union \$5 card printed Credit Union. Theoretically, any number of cards could be produced on this serial number - even 2 million cards!! What has occurred to date, however, is that each institution has had printed three denominational values at the same time. For example, the Credit Union has printed cards numbered 49517 to 49519. The number 49517 was printed/encoded with a \$5 value, card 49518 was printed/encoded with a \$20 value and 49519 was printed/encoded with the \$50 value.

These three cards were printed with consecutive numbers beginning with the \$5 card, then the \$20 and finally the \$50 card. It is believed that no missing numbers were allowed.

By studying the number ranges of cards it is possible to hazard a guess as to how many were made for each denomination/institution. Not all \$5 cards were printed in the same quantity for example.

Before the card number (as opposed to the serial number), lies a 4 digit number. This number is an identifier for the particular institution. For example, 5022 is the number code for the NAB. It is noticed that the Disposable cards have number codes of 5021, 5022, 5023, 5024 and 5025 on each denomination card. The disposable cards are actually split into five groups and each card can be identified as an ANZ, an NAB, a Credit Union or a Westpack card!

I was going to list all the serial codes here but these were supplied by another contributor elsewhere in the magazine.

The quantities for the Cafeteria Trial cards are listed below. A fairly reliable guesstimate can be made for those without exact numbers detailed.

As more institutions come aboard after the trial extends over the whole of Australia, each new institution will have their own card number code. Each new printing will then have a single serial number, the institution card code, followed by the actual card number. This allows the institution to monitor quantities/security and Visa Cash to monitor the actual card (using the serial number and card number). The institution card code is only needed for visual inspection to see who the cards are to be delivered to!

PHONECARDS ON PHONECARDS

A phonecard that I recently received from a friend in Sweden is the one pictured below from Greece. "Phonecards on Phonecards" being one of the themes that I collect, I was most happy to receive this card as it was new to me.



From the details on the card it appears that it was issued to promote the **Greek OTE Payphone Card Collector Service**. The date on the card is 11/94 and the quantity issued is also shown as being 1,200,000 cards - so it should certainly not be a hard one to find! The reverse of the card is fully taken up with a 1995 Calendar.

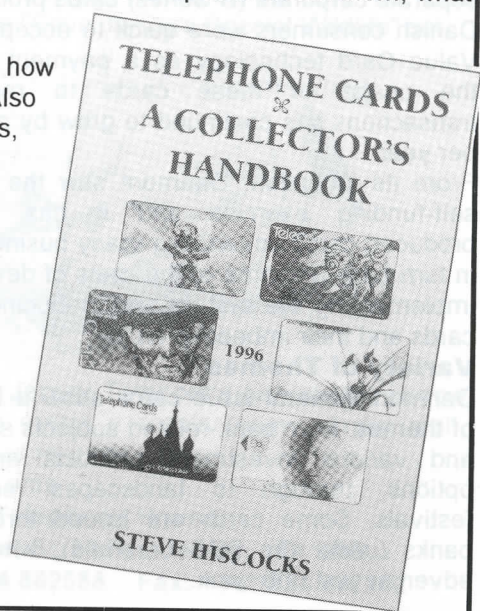

STORED VALUE CARDS

Last month's article on the new Tele Danmark chip phonecards touched briefly on Denmark's Stored Value Cards, produced by Danmont, a company owned by Tele Danmark and PBS (the Danish banks' automated payment system, akin to EFTPOS). The Danmont Stored Value Cards are the subject of this article.

Technology Used By Visa

Danmont SVCs are very similar to Australia's Visa Cash cards - in fact Danmont developed the automated stored cash system used by Visa, and so Denmark must be considered the mother country of the Visa Cash card also.

In 1995, Visa International purchased a license from Danmont to use their system on its Visa Cash cards, which now operate on a trial basis in the USA for the Atlanta Olympic Games and on the Gold Coast in Australia, and are to be trialled also in Canada, Hong Kong and a number of other countries.

Currently Danmont and Visa are jointly developing a re-loadable stored value card system, which is already being trialled "in-house" by a number of Australian and US banks.

Introduction of Danmont

Danmont was formed in 1992 as a joint venture between Tele Denmark and the Danish banks. After a successful trial of the technology in Naestved, a relatively small regional centre in Denmark, it was implemented nationally during 1993 and has expanded ever since. To date there have been over 100 general issue (D-Series) cards and another 30 separate corporate (B-Series) cards produced.

Danish consumers were quick to accept the Stored Value Card technology as a payment option, and the usage of these cards to replace cash transactions has continued to grow by almost 200% per year.

From its inception, Danmont saw the SVCs as a self-funding exercise and it has successfully produced cards advertising many businesses, which in turn pays for some of the costs of developing and implementing the system and producing the plastic cards and their imbedded chips.

Variety of Themes

Danmont general issue cards show a large variety of themes, from bank-related subjects such as coins and various investment products and payment options, through to landscapes, sculpture and festivals. Some cards are issued through all the banks (under the PBS umbrella), whereas others advertise just one bank.

Other cards are issued by Danmont itself for community projects (eg. those promoting special festivals), or as advertising for particular firms including many well-known brands (eg. IBM, Avis, Miele, Coke, Siemens, Pepsi and Quaker Oats). There has even been a Danmont card issued to advertise MasterCard, Visa's largest global competitor.

General issue cards normally carry denominations of between 100 and 300 Danish Kroner (about A\$20 TO A\$60), and are issued in quantities of around 5,000 to 10,000 each.

Danmont corporate cards generally carry denominations of DKr10 to DKr50, and are designed to be offered as premiums for promotions or as corporate gifts. Quite a number of businesses buying advertising on general issue cards have also issued their own corporate cards. These cards are usually issued in quantities around 2000 of each.

The smaller issues are made viable because they are all sold to the advertiser at a premium over their face value, although some are made available to collectors through SammlerService, the Danish distributor of Danmont cards to collectors.

Easily Available

Danmont cards can be bought from many of the same locations one would expect to buy phonecards, as well as from banks and post offices. They can be used in the 4000 or so public phones throughout the country, as well as in hundreds of train stations, post offices, schools and convenience stores.

Confusion?

With Tele Danmark announcing its conversion to using compatible chip cards as its new phonecards, the lines between phonecards and Stored Value Cards in Denmark will become very blurred - at first glance it will be impossible to tell a Danmont Kr100 SVC from a Tele Denmark Kr100 phonecard, as both can be used in phones.

However, Tele Danmark has confirmed its commitment to keep phonecards as a separate product - its main reason seems to be that SVCs are too expensive to produce to allow them to be used to replace low-value phonecards - and since it owns 50% of Danmont, it is well placed to make this assessment.

Time to Collect

For the collector of SVCs, the time to put aside some Danmont cards seems to be right now - first, they are a fitting fore-runner to Visa Cash cards, but more importantly, when Danish phonecard collectors look to buy the Danmont range to complete their card collections, the relatively miniscule print runs will mean that the Danmont cards could be snapped up quite quickly - remembering that the normal print-run for phonecards is 100,000 or more, in comparison to 10,000 or less for the Danmont cards.

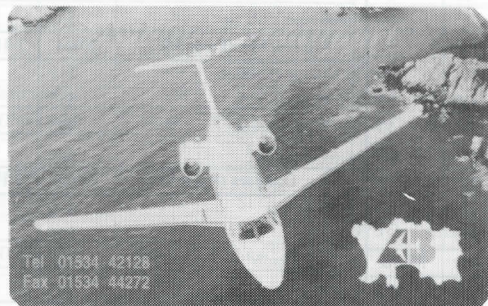

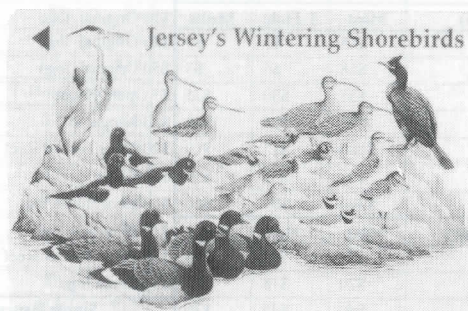

THE PHONECARDS OF THAILAND

Part 8. Allan Douglas

The following is a continuation of the checklist of the phonecards of Thailand which was commenced in the October 1995 issue of The Australasian Phonocard Monthly.

In part 7 of this checklist of Thai phonecards (June '96 APM), it was stated that with the issue of the butterfly set of 4 cards on 30-09-94, we saw for the first time the number of Baht 50 cards drop to 50,000 cards. This was meant to be the Baht 25 cards. Only a year earlier, the number of Baht 25 cards issued for the Thai Cultural Dance set was listed as 150,000. The Baht 200 card for the same set was listed at 200,000 cards. With the issue of the Butterfly set the numbers of Baht 25 cards issued dropped to 50,000 and the same applied to the Baht 200 cards.

As I stated in part 7, the Baht 50 and 100 cards are the most popular cards that customers buy so it is quite understandable that those two values would have much larger numbers issued.

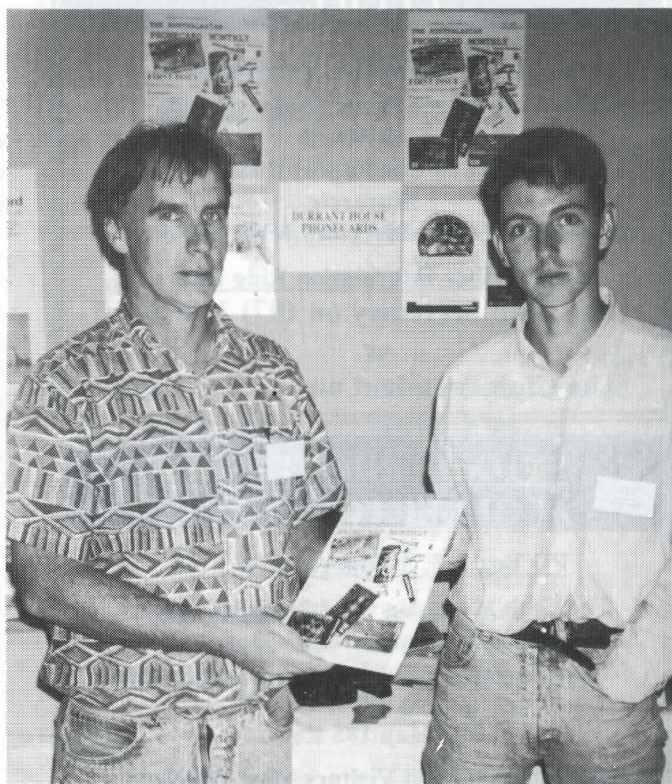

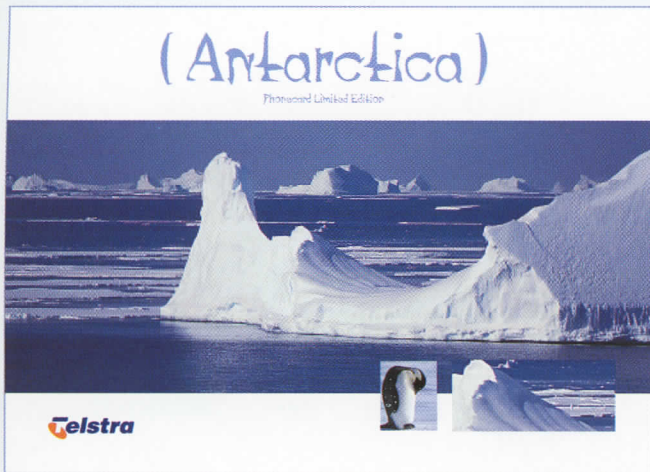
